WHAT TO DO IF YOU HIT A CAT



STOP! 

Please don't drive off. They are not 'just a cat'. They are part of someone's family. Cats feel the same pain that we do, their instinct is just to hide it better from predators.

HELP! 

If the cat has survived the accident, they will need to see a veterinarian straight away. You will not be charged for this. Your closest vet can be found at www.findavet.rcvs.org.uk

REPORT IT! 

If the cat is sadly deceased 1) Move the body to the side of the road 2) Check for an ID tag & knock on surrounding doors to locate the owner 3) A local vet or rescue will scan for a microchip, or a local Scan Angel: www.microchipcentral.com/find-a-scan-angel/ 4) Post details on lost/found social media pages.
